

1. The number of paper and maximum marks for each paper/practical shall be shown in the syllabus for the subject concerned, It will be necessary for a Candidate to pass in the theory part as well as in practical part (wherever prescribed) of a subject/paper separately.
2. A candidate for a pass at each of the Previous and the Final Examinations shall be required to obtain:
 - (i) At least 36% marks in the aggregate of all the papers prescribed for the examination and
 - (ii) At least 36% marks in practical(s) wherever prescribed at the examination, provided that if candidate fails to secure atleast 25% marks in each individual paper at the examination and also in the dissertation/survey report field work, wherever prescribed / he shall be deemed to have failed at the examination notwithstanding has having obtained the minimum percentage of marks required in the aggregate for that examination. No division shall be awarded at the end of the final examination on the combined marks obtained at the Previous and the final Examination taken together, as noted below :

First Division 60%	}	of the aggregate marks taken together
Second Division 48%		for the previous and the final examination.
3. All the rest will be declared to have passed the examination if a candidate clears any Papers(s) Practical (S) Dissertation prescribed at the Previous and/or Final Examination after a Continuous Period of three years, then for the purpose of working out his division the minimum pass marks only viz. 25%(36% in the case of Practical) shall be taken into account in respect of such Paper(s)/Practical (S) Dissertation are clear after the expire of the aforesaid period of three years provided that in case where a candidate required more

than 25% marks in order to reach the minimum aggregate as many mark out of those actually secured by him will be taken into account as would enable him to make up the deficiency in the requisite minimum aggregate.

4. 4 The Thesis. Dissertation/ Survey Report/Field work shall be type- written and submitted in triplicate so as to reach the office of the Registrar atleast 3 weeks before the commencement of the theory examinations. Only such candidates shall be permitted to offer dissertation/Field Work Survey Report Thesis (if provided in the scheme of examination) in lieu of a paper as have secured atleast 55% marks in the aggregate of all the papers prescribed for the previous examination in the case of annul scheme irrespective of the number of papers in which a candidate actually appeared at the examination

N.B. Non – Collegiate candidate are not eligible to offer dissertation as

General Scheme of Question Papers

Each Question paper shall be of three hours duration and of 100 marks. Each Question paper shall consist of three parts.

Part- I shall carry 20 marks and shall consist of 10 compulsory questions of 2 Marks compulsory Answered in 20-25 words each.

Part- II shall carry 20 marks and shall consist of 4 compulsory questions of 5 marks each to be answered in 150 words each.

Part- III of the question paper shall carry 60 marks, this part shall be divided into 3 sections comprising of 2 essay type questions of 20 marks each. Candidate will be required to attempt one question from each section (3question in all, one from each section).
