

**INTERIM CONSTITUTION OF  
THE MAHARAJA SURAJMAL BRIJ UNIVERSITY STUDENT'S UNION  
BHARATPUR**

2018

**Chapter-I : AIMS AND OBJECTIVES**

1. The University hereby formulates, the MS Brij University Student's Union Constitution with the following aims and objectives:
- a) to promote mutual contact, a democratic out-look and spirit of oneness amongst the students of the MS Brij University;
  - b) to promote the social, cultural and intellectual development of the students of the MSBU,
  - c) to promote consciousness amongst the students of the MSBU of the events taking place around them-with a view to better equip them as responsible and educated citizen
  - d) to promote amongst the students of the MSBU a sense of service to the society and duty towards the state; and
  - e) to promote harmonious relations amongst all the sections of the University community.

**Chapter-II : SHORT TITLE, EXTENT AND COMMENCEMENT**

2. This may be called interim Constitution of the MS Brij University Student's Union 2018-19, Bharatpur.
3. This Constitution shall apply to all the Post-graduate Departments/Units (by whatever name they are called) and the constituent Colleges of the University including BALLB students of MSB Global Law Institute.
4. This Constitution shall come into force on 25-7-2018 which is the date of approval by the Vice-Chancellor under Section 12 (6) of the Act.
5. **Definitions:** In these rules unless the context requires :
- a) **Student:** "Student" means a person who is on the rolls of a PG Department/Unit (by whatever name it is called)/Constituent College of the University pursuing a regular course of study other than Ph.D. in the current academic session. He/she shall not be employed anywhere.
  - b) **Maharaja Surajmal Brij University Students' Union :** "MS Brij University Students Union means the union at the university level of all the students on rolls in the current academic session excluding M. Phil. and Ph.D. students.

**Chapter III : ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE**

6. There shall be one union at the University level of all the students of the P.G. Departments/Units (by whatever name they are called) and the MSB Global Law Institute of the University, called 'MS Brij University Students' Union.
7. Students Union in MSB Global Law Institute shall be made from 2020-21. This year to encourage democratic values a class representative shall be elected, and students shall be voters in the MSBU Students Union elections.

- h) Concerned itself with the publication in furtherance of education, social service and activities.
- i) Such other activities as approved by the Patron.

**10. Chief Patron and Patrons**

- a) The vice-Chancellor of the University shall be the Patron of the MSBU Students' Union and shall be Chief Patron of other Unions when formed.
- b) In later years, the Heads of the concerning Departments/in-charges of the Units (by whatever name they are called) shall be the Patrons of the Student's Unions in their respective Departments/Units. The Principals of the Constituent Colleges shall be the Patrons of Students Unions in their respective colleges.

**11. Powers and Functions of The Patrons/The Chief Patron**

The patron shall exercise the general supervision and overall authority over the affairs of the respective Union under his/her jurisdiction.

**12. Dean, Student's Welfare when appointed shall exercise general supervision and control over all the activities of the MS Brij University Students Union.**

There may be opened a bank account which the DSW will operate in the name of the MSBU students Union for which rules shall be made and adopted.

**13. The Union Shall have an Executive Council which shall consist of the President and class representatives for 2018-19.**

**14. Office Bearer of MS Brij University Students Union**

- a) Further for year 2018-19 the candidates contesting for the post of President and shall have to be

- i) Not more than the age of 25 years ( 28 years for a student of PG Course in Law).
- ii) Student of any Post-Graduate course of study.

OR  
Student of the 4th or 5th year of any five year integrated course of study,

- b) Further for 2018-19 provided that candidates contesting for the post of class Representative to the MSBU students Union shall have to be

- i) Not more than the age of 25 years (28 years for a student of PG Course in Law)

- c) The office bearers of the Union shall be responsible for orderly functioning of the Union.

**15. Functions of Office Bearer of the MS Brij University Students Union/Constituent College Students Union**

**President :** The President of the Union will be the Chief Executive of the Union and will function in all matters relating to the Union in accordance with this Constitution and with class representatives.

- b) The Vice-Chancellor will appoint the Chief Election Officer who will be a teacher of the university, not below the rank of an Associate Professor. The Chief Election Officer will be assisted by a Committee.
- c) A notification for the election is issued under the signature of the Chief Election Officer as much as per govt. notification which could be complied.
- d) The results of the University Students' Union will be declared by the Returning Officer. The oath of office to the Office bearers shall also be administered by the concerned Patron(s) immediately after the declaration of results(s).
- e) The maximum permitted expenditure by a contestant for election shall be Rs. 5,000/-. Expenditure above this limit will disqualify the contestant.
- f) Each candidate shall, within fifteen days of the declaration of the result, submit complete and certified accounts of election expenses to the Chief Election Officer, through Returning Officer.
- g) The Chief Election Officer shall publish such certified accounts within 2 days of submission of such accounts, through University website so that any member of the students body may freely examine the same.
- h) The election of the candidate will be nullified by the Chief Election Officer in the event of any non-compliance or in the event of any excessive expenditure after giving due opportunity of hearing.

i) With the view to prevent the inflow of funds from political parties into the student election process, the candidates are specially barred from utilizing funds from any other sources other than voluntary contributions from the students members.

#### 19. Code of Conduct

All the candidates contesting the elections for any post or office of the University Students Union and also their agents and supporters shall abide by the following code of conduct which will be operational from first day of commencement of academic session:-

- a) No candidate shall indulge in, nor shall abet, any activity, which may aggravate existing differences or create mutual hatred or cause tension between different castes and communities, religious or linguistic, or between any group(s) of students.
- b) Criticism of other candidate, when made, shall be confined to their policies and programmes, past records and work. Candidates shall refrain from criticism of all aspects of private life, not connected with public activities of the other candidates or supporters of such other candidates. Criticism of other candidates, or their supporters based on unverified allegations or distortion shall be avoided.
- c) There shall be no appeal to caste or communal feelings for securing vote. Places of worship, within or without the campus shall not be used for election propaganda.

**CHAPTER-VII: MISCELLANEOUS**

**21. Rule making**

*8/10/18 - constitution*

The Vice-Chancellor may appoint a committee for framing such rules as may be necessary for the working of this Constitutions and rules shall be adopted when accepted by VC.

**22. Interpretation of this constitution and removal of doubts and difficulties.**

In the case of any doubt or ambiguity in any provisions of the Interim Constitution, the rulings given by the Vice-Chancellor shall be final.

**23. Dissolution**

The MSB University union may be suspended or dissolved by the Vice-Chancellor, at any time, if so warranted by the circumstances, in consultation with the BOM.
