विषय:- एलएल.बी. 3 वर्षीय परीक्षा प्रणाली से सेमेस्टर प्रणाली के नियम।

महोदय,

विश्वविद्यालय द्वारा एलएल.बी. 3 वर्षीय पाठ्यक्रम में इस वर्ष से ड्यू पेपर्स या सप्लीमेन्ट्री के पेपर्स देने का प्रबन्ध विद्यार्थियों की सुविधा को ध्यान में रखते हुए तैयार कर दिया गया है। दोनों राजकीय विधि कॉलेजों के प्राचार्यों से बातचीत करली गई थी।

Yearly system से Semester system में transition को बेहद सरल बनाया गया है। इसका English Version authentic है। सभी विद्यार्थियों को भरपूर chance भी दिए गए हैं। विद्यार्थी प्रारम्भ से ही अपनी पढ़ाई सुनिश्चित करें और बाद में न अटकें इसकी व्यवस्था करने का प्रयत्न किया गया है।

हिन्दी में भी संक्षिप्त में वर्णित किया गया है। प्राचार्य महोदयों से अपेक्षा है कि वे इनको समझकर विद्यार्थियों को guide करें और जिन due papers का ex-student का कार्य बाकी है उनकी परीक्षा कब ली जाए, इसके बारे में अपने विमर्श विश्वविद्यालय को प्रस्तुत करें। जैसे कि पेपर संख्या 1.6 एवं 1.8 आदि।

अगर कोई difficulty आती है तो उसे डा. अरुण कुमार पाण्डेय, उपकुलसचिव से लिखित में पूछें उसका निदान किया जाएगा।

3 year Year LLB divided in Semester system- General

Certain rules were already declared for transition from Yearly system of LLB examination to Semester examination system, wherein admissions and promotions continue to be on yearly basis. Yearly system till 2016 had 9 papers in each year. Two semester system in each year has 5 papers in each of the 6 Semesters, totaling to 30 papers. All papers have been given a number in which first digit denotes semester, similar to previous 1. X, 2.x, 3.x. The comparative chart of papers is notified with this notification.

Rules for change from Annual System 3 year LLB. Course to Semester System 3 year LLB. Course divided in six semesters.

The following decisions were taken in the meeting of BOS Chairman with two Principals of Government Colleges Sh. KS Mishra and Dr Neelu Goyal in October 2018. The rest is clarifications arising from difficulties.




LLB is still 3 year system for admissions and promotions. The total span period for completing LLB degree w.e.f. admissions from 2017-18 has been fixed at 6 years. The span period for all admissions made prior to 2017-18 shall also lapse after 3 chances of passing 3rd year in 2018-2019 when regular students write LLB third year as regular candidates. For LLB final year the candidates will be given time as ex student till year 2021 and they can avail all chances whenever the exam in that paper is held in any semester.

A candidate admitted in 2017-18 who does not complete his degree in six years would have to do it afresh from LLB 1st year with new admission.

Important: - The benefit of semester system lies in the fact that once a paper has been passed, it need not be repeated or passed again, even if there is delay in promotion. Thus once the 7 out of 10 papers have been passed the candidate shall be promoted to IInd year. If promotion is withheld as requisite number of papers of Ist & IInd sem are not passed it would not require student to write the papers again and the candidate will be promoted on passing of 7 papers as per rules. Similarly for IIIrd year promotion would take place on passing of 16 papers.

At least once the exam of Second year and IIIrd year on old pattern will be conducted in the year Sept 2019 after second semester exams of May 2019. Students can write their exams in **due papers** of yearly system for IInd and IIIrd year in any of the semester system exams from Jan 2019 itself.

Exams for **Regular Annual system** would end this year in **May 2019**. Second and IIIrd yr exams in Annual system will be conducted in supple in Sept 2019. The due papers of Ist and IIIrd Sem can be written in Jan 2019 and May 2019. (Whenever exam in the relevant paper is held) Thereafter due papers can be given in the same paper in I/III/V semester in Dec 2019 and II/IV /VI semester in May 2020 as per rules.

Supplementary exams would be on the basis of the current syllabus of semester system except in those papers, where changes are substantial, more than 40% or more, e.g., Legal System in India in 1st year and constitution in 1st year (Only as due paper) of 1st year.

Rules

1. (a) Semester system was introduced with effect from session 2017-18 in place of annual system of 3 years LLB course. In semester system there shall be 6 semesters in three years and each year is divided in two semesters. Each semester shall have 5 papers and thus instead of 27 papers now from 2017-18 the candidates would pass 30 papers.
- (b) The semesters would be numbered consecutively as I to VIth semester but admissions and promotions are year-wise i.e. from 1st year to IInd yr and from IInd year to IIIrd year.
- (c) Candidate has to pass all 30 papers: for passing with 40% in each paper and 48% for obtaining LLB degree. The total span period for LLB is fixed at 6 yrs. If all 30 papers are not completed within 6 years from admission in LLB 1st semester, the candidate would have to take fresh admission in LLB 1st year.
2. The pass percentage has been raised to 40% from past 36% so that the candidates after qualifying the paper, have to make up only 8% to reach minimum 48% pass marks in aggregate.
 - (a) There shall be automatic promotion of students on completion of attendance from Ist to IInd semester, and from third to IVth and V to VI semesters on completion of attendance. Candidates shall have to qualify prescribed number of 7 papers out of 10 for promotion to IInd year with 48% in aggregate in minimum of 4 papers. The detaining rules in account of shortage of attendance would now be applicable on semester basis. Candidate would have to take admission next year in same semester.
 - (b) (for 2018-19 concessional promotion on passing 6 papers was given, that would not be repeated at all. Walk out from exam would attract disciplinary action.)
 - (c) If the attendance of a candidate does not comply with rules as applicable previously, the candidate cannot be allowed to write the exams and candidate cannot move to next semester even within the same year.
3. (a) For promotion to IIIrd year i.e. V semester qualification of papers is 16 out of 20 as laid down below. The movement from 5th Semester to VI semester is automatic on completion of attendance. For promotion to LLB IIIrd year minimum of 16 papers, out of which 48% aggregate in minimum of 13 papers and pass with 40% marks in remaining 3 more papers.
- (b) Thus the candidate would have $48 \times 13 = 624$ marks in 13 papers and would also qualify 3 more papers. Thus minimum of 16 papers should have been qualified with 48% aggregate taken together in 13 papers.
- (c) A student who fails to be promoted to IInd year i.e. (3rd semester) or IIIrd year (5th semester) having completed attendance shall not have to attend classes for the semester. He will appear in remaining papers alongwith semester examination.
If and when he clears requisite number of papers, then he will get admission to IInd year 3rd semester or IIIrd year 5th semester as applicable in his case.

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- (d) It has been decided to revise the course syllabus every year in each paper. It should be understood by examinees that the examination of each year for due papers to qualify for any course or paper shall be held as per the course syllabus for the year of exam in that course and not what was the syllabus for the year when candidate was regular student.


Transition from Yearly system to Semester System for Completing LLB (Specific cases)

Some queries have arisen this year and some may arise next year when promotion to IIIrd year shall be made for those who were admitted to LLB earlier than session 2017-18. They have been explained below:

4. It was decided that from 2017-18 the regular study of LLB shall be in semester system. From 2018-19 the regular study in LLB IInd year is organized under IIIrd & IVth semester system. LLB IIIrd year for 2018-19 continues in Yearly mode. From 2019-20 the LLB I, II, IIIrd year shall have regular study /only in semester system,
5. For students of annual system exams who had taken admission in the year 2016-17 or earlier, a full scale system of passing their due papers as Ex students or back papers of Ist year (Ist & IInd semester) and also for 2nd year (IIIrd and IVth semester) and for IIIrd year following rules and procedure shall apply.
6. **In nutshell it means that whenever the examination in old paper of yearly scheme (See paper no of corresponding paper from chart in schedule) is being held, the candidate should write that exam along with fresh students. The old paper number and new paper number shall be carried and printed on question paper.**

Note: It has been decided to give maximum of 3 chances for passing their due or back papers for students of IInd yr. and IIIrd yr. and students of Ist and Second semester can pass within 6 years till 2023. Thus exam in any paper can be taken along with Ist and IIIrd semester examinations in Jan 2019, or IInd & IVth semester exam in May 2019 or in supplementary exam. after the annual semester exam in May 2019.

7. **The case of LL.B. 2nd year students of session 2017-18 (in yearly mode) shall get following three chances to clear their due papers.**
 - a) The examination of all the courses being taught in LLB Ist Semester and LLB IIIrd semester (the list can be seen from Schedule), are being held in Dec 2018 (this year for reason of late session exam shall be in Jan-Feb 2019).
 - b) **The students who are studying in yearly system in LLB IIIrd year** or have only to pass the papers to clear their due paper of LLB Ist year or LLB IInd year, should write the exam for that paper whenever it is being held in any of four semesters. Thus the students of LLB IIIrd year are eligible to write exams for their due papers in Jan/ Feb 2019, if the exam in that paper is being held in any of Ist to IVth semesters.



- c) Students are advised to check in which semester their due paper is being taught, (from the list attached) they should fill in exam form in Jan 2019 and write their exam mentioning their old paper number and new paper number, for which the provision shall be made in the examination form to be filled in.
- i) a) One Chance may be availed for any or all papers along with semester exams in December – Jan 2019 for Ist and Illrd Semester papers. This can be availed in subsequent years.
- b) Similarly for papers of yearly system which fall in IInd and/or IV semester the 1st chance can be availed for those papers in May-June 2019
- ii) **Second** chance can be availed for due papers of LLB IInd year and /or LLB Illrd year (yearly system) in the supplementary exam of LLB 2nd year and LLB 3rd year which will be held after the regular semester exams, likely to be held in Aug- Sept 2019.
- iii) Third & Last chance for due papers along with I, III, V semester exams in Dec 2019 and in II, IV, VI semester examination in May 2020.
- iv) **All students who have passed papers of Ist year or IInd year or Illrd year would not have to write whole of Ist year at all, but only the remaining papers. But all previous students of before 2017-18, if they do not clear their LLB within 7 years from date of admission will not be entitled to write their exams after 2021 or whichever is later.**
8. Thus a present student of LLB Illrd year or any student who has not passed or promoted to IInd yr or Illrd year can and shall write that paper whenever the examination in that paper is being held in any of the semesters I & III in Dec- Jan or in -May for IInd and IVth semester examinations.

9. (A) LL.B.Illrd year students of session 2018-19 will appear in their main annual examination in session end exam of 2018-19 and will get three chances of passing their exams or due papers as follows:-

(I) They can start taking chances for papers of Ist yr and IInd year from January 2019 itself. Another chance of due papers along with I and III and V semester exams in Dec 2019 and II, IV, VI semester examination in May 2020. The exam should be written by seeing Schedule I that whenever the exam in the relevant due paper is held.

(II) 3rd chance of due papers in supple examination for 2nd and Illrd year after the regular examination in Aug-Sept 2019.

(III) Last chance of passing due papers in I, III, V semester examination in Dec 2020 and II, IV, VI semester exam in May 2021 examinations.

The University may give more chances of remaining students admitted earlier but chances of candidates who have not passed in six years would now be limited to three hereafter.

15. (i) For students who have passed their papers of LLB 1st year in 2017-18 as ex students and are promoted to LLB IIInd year in session 2018-19. Their passing LLB 1st year with 9 papers shall be accepted as 1st year pass.

(ii) They will write their examination in a manner that from 2018-19 they will be regular students of LLB 2nd year and shall pass IIIrd and IV semesters (10 papers each year), also see Schedule I. Following special arrangement is made for them: If there is still any due paper pending, they may pass that paper in any semester whenever and in whichever semester its exam is conducted, they will be allowed. They will pass their 9 papers as prescribed in 2016-17 as LLB 1st year. In addition, they will pass those papers which are now taught in 1st and IIInd semester, but were not passed by the candidate in his 1st year.

Such student of LLB IIInd year (Old Course) will not study a paper which he has already passed in 1st year because of reshuffling of some papers.

(iii) Note :-

1. जो स्टूडेंट इस बार एलएलबी. प्रथम वर्ष वार्षिक प्रणाली से पास करके आए हैं, और LLB. IIInd year में Regular student पढ़ रहे हैं, उन्हें तीसरे सेमेस्टर में constitutional Law-II नहीं पढ़ना होगा। इसके बदले उन्हें Ist semester का paper No. 104 Property Law and Easements का पेपर पढ़ना व exam देना होगा।

2. इन्हीं स्टूडेंट को चौथे सेमेस्टर में एक अतिरिक्त पेपर दूसरे सेमेस्टर का Paper No. 205 (Law of Crimes) की परीक्षा चौथे सेमेस्टर के साथ IIInd Semester की देनी होगी। इनको Paper No. 405 नहीं देना होगा, चूंकि ये स्टूडेंट Paper No. 405 Ist year में 1.9 की तरह दे चुके हैं।

16. Such a student who has passed as regular student of LLB 2nd year in 2018-19, he would be given LLB degree after passing his 9 papers of 1st year and 10 papers each of IIInd year and IIIrd year. Thus such a student shall be given degree of LLB after passing 29 papers instead of 27 papers. This will be referred as Old LLB Scheme of 2016.

Similarly an old scheme for those who qualify to be admitted in LLB IIIrd year in July 2019, they shall complete their 18 papers of LLB 1st and IIInd year, as per old scheme. They shall then in third year pass 10 papers of LLB Vth and sixth semester. They will pass the LLB with 28 papers. This will also be referred as Old LLB Scheme of 2016

Promotion in LLB IIIrd year in July 2019-20

17. The ex students completing their LLB 2nd year after passing their due papers and becoming entitled promotion in LLB 3rd year in 2019-20, will be allowed admission in IIIrd year. The students have to pass their degree. Such students of LLB IIIrd year shall have to pass 9+9 papers for 1st year and IIInd year.

If there is required any adjustment for a paper having been shifted to another semester and or year, such regular students of LLB IIIrd year would be required to pass 10 papers in V and VI semester. They will not study a paper in which they have already passed in LLB 1st and LLB IIInd year (if any). If any paper of LLB IIIrd year of old scheme of 2016 has been shifted to LLB 1st yr or LLB IIInd year they shall write the

exam for such papers of IIIrd year in the corresponding paper being taught in any of 4 semesters of Ist and/or IIInd year. The same shall be adjusted and examination shall be held. They will pass LLB old scheme after 28 Papers.

18. **If there remains a doubt or problems persist** such students would meet the designated officer in CE Office/ Academic Branch. One/two papers for them will be structured in a manner that they pass all essential papers without any inconvenience to students overseeing they are entitled to LLB degree in BCI regulations. This concession is extended to save their already passed courses.

19. Certain Explanations

A minimum of 29 papers if they are regular students of LLB 2nd year in 2018-19 and should end their LLB regular degree till 2020. For those who are admitted as regular students from 2017-18 would have to qualify minimum of 30 papers and have an aggregate of 48% in all 30 papers as also in number of papers necessary for promotion to IIInd yr and IIIrd year.

Those students who were admitted in 2016-17 or before, if they are regular students in 2018-19 and /or 2019-20, of second year or Third year they shall pass 10 papers from that semester. The students who complete their IIIrd year as regular student within 2018-19 thereafter they will write all their exams as ex students they will their pass LLB degree with 27 papers. They must complete their degree within 2021, availing 3 chances after their LLB Final year.

20. A candidate who has failed in more than three or all papers of LL.B. 2nd /3rd year annual examination of 2017-18 is getting one chance of appearing in all papers as ex-student in examination after session examination in 2018-19.

In the light of above points if a student fails to pass any of the above examination of LL.B. I, II and IIIrd year in the above given one chance, for IIInd year and IIIrd year then he will be required to pass remaining papers in semester system along with equivalent papers in the semester as applicable (see schedule).

If there is no equivalent paper of annual system in semester system, then Controller of Examination, would make alternate arrangement for conducting examination in a corresponding paper for such candidate for such paper, which he has not studied or passed.

21. **Those students who have completed IIIrd year as regular students till 2018-19, and have to appear as ex students hereafter, pass per centage for ex students shall continue to be 36% for upto May 2021. For all regular students pass percentage from 2017-18 is now 40%.**

एलएल.बी. 3 वर्षीय परीक्षा प्रणाली से सेमेस्टर प्रणाली में जाने के संक्षिप्त नियम

1. सत्र 2017-18 से 3 वर्षीय एलएल.बी. वार्षिक परीक्षा प्रणाली 2016 तक (LLB 2016) के स्थान पर सेमेस्टर प्रणाली लागू की गई है। प्रत्येक वर्ष 2 सेमेस्टर होंगे। कुल तीन वर्ष में 6 सेमेस्टर होंगे। प्रत्येक सेमेस्टर में 5 पेपर्स होंगे, इस प्रकार छात्रों को 27 पेपर्स के स्थान पर 30 पेपर्स पास करने होंगे।
2. सेमेस्टर प्रणाली में 1 से 6 सेमेस्टर होंगे। छात्रों का प्रमोशन प्रत्येक साल के आधार पर किया जाएगा। जैसे प्रथम वर्ष, द्वितीय वर्ष एवं तृतीय वर्ष आदि।
3. छात्रों को सभी पेपर्स में अलग अलग कम से कम 40 प्रतिशत अंक पास करने के लिए चाहिए परन्तु कुल योग 48 प्रतिशत आवश्यक होगा। तीन वर्षीय डिग्री को पूरा करने की अधिकतम समय सीमा 6 वर्ष है। यदि छात्र 6 वर्ष में 30 पेपर्स पास नहीं कर पाता है तो उसे प्रथम वर्ष में दुबारा प्रवेश लेना होगा।

परीक्षा में बैठने के लिए छात्रों को पुराने नियमों के अनुसार अपनी उपस्थिति प्रत्येक सेमेस्टर में रखनी होगी। उपस्थिति कम होने पर परीक्षा में नहीं बैठने दिया जाएगा।

4. (a) जिन छात्रों को पहले, दूसरे और तीसरे वर्ष (old system) के ड्यू पेपर्स देने हैं वह अपना फार्म Comparative Chart को देखकर New Id no. of the same paper का Number भरेंगे। इनमें जिन विषयों में परीक्षा जनवरी 2019 व मई 2019 में होनी है उसकी सूची संलग्न परीक्षा शाखा तैयार कर रही है। छात्र संलग्न लिस्ट से यह देखे कि उनके ड्यू पेपर्स किस सेमेस्टर में पढाए जाएंगे।

(b) एलएल.बी. द्वितीय वर्ष, तृतीय वर्ष 2016 व सेमेस्टर प्रणाली 2017 के छात्रों को ड्यू पेपर्स/बैक पेपर्स किसी भी पेपर की परीक्षा प्रथम एवं तीसरे सेमेस्टर की जनवरी 2019 की परीक्षाओं के साथ दे सकते हैं, अन्य पेपर्स की परीक्षा द्वितीय एवं चतुर्थ सेमेस्टर मई 2019 में ली जाएगी। इसके बाद पूरक परीक्षा में होगी।

5. एलएल.बी. वार्षिक प्रणाली 2016 के तृतीय वर्ष के छात्र प्रथम वर्ष एवं द्वितीय वर्ष के ड्यू पेपर्स पास करने के लिए ड्यू पेपर्स की परीक्षा पैरा 4 के अनुसार जनवरी/ फरवरी 2019 व मई 2019 और सितम्बर 2019 में भी दे सकते हैं।

6. जनवरी 2019 के फार्म भरते समय छात्र पेपर्स के पुराने एवं नए नम्बर लिखेंगे, इसके लिए परीक्षा शाखा फार्म में आवश्यक संशोधन करेगा।

7. द्वितीय वर्ष (तृतीय सेमेस्टर) में प्रमोशन के लिए 10 में से 7 पेपर्स पास करने और कम से कम 4 पेपर में 48 प्रतिशत अंक होने पर होगा। तृतीय सेमेस्टर में उपस्थिति पूरी होने पर चतुर्थ सेमेस्टर में जाना **automatic** है।

8. एलएल.बी. द्वितीय वर्ष सत्र 2018-19 के छात्रों को एलएलबी. की डिग्री प्रथम वर्ष के 9 व द्वितीय एवं तीसरे वर्ष के 10-10 पेपर्स कुल 29 पेपर्स पास करने पर दी जाएगी।

9. पाँचवे से छठवें सेमेस्टर में उपस्थिति पूर्ण होने पर **automatic** प्रमोशन होगा।

(अ) तृतीय वर्ष में प्रमोशन के लिए कुल 16 पेपर उत्तीर्ण करने आवश्यक हैं। जिनमें 13 पेपर्स में 48 प्रतिशत **aggregate** अंक प्राप्त करना अनिवार्य होगा। इस प्रकार छात्रों को 13 प्रश्नपत्रों में $48 \times 13 = 624$ अंक प्राप्त करने होंगे। साथ ही शेष तीन प्रश्नपत्रों को भी उत्तीर्ण करना होगा।

(सत्र 2018-19 में छूट देते हुए केवल 6 प्रश्नपत्रों को उत्तीर्ण करने पर प्रमोशन दिए गए हैं। इसमें पुनः छूट नहीं दी जाएगी और तृतीय वर्ष में प्रवेश 16 पेपर पास करने पर होगा)

(ब) अगर कोई छात्र तृतीय वर्ष में प्रमोट होने में असफल हो जाता है, तो वह पुराने सेमेस्टर की परीक्षा जनवरी 2019 व मई 2019 में दे सकता है। जैसे ही वह पेपर्स की वांछित संख्या पूरी कर लेता है, वह तृतीय वर्ष के पाँचवें सेमेस्टर में प्रमोशन के लिए योग्य हो जाएगा।

10. यदि किसी विद्यार्थी को अपनी पूर्व परीक्षा का **aggregate** अंक पूर्ण करना है, तो वह किन्हीं भी परीक्षाओं में जिनका वह **student** था में सम्मिलित हो सकता है।

1. जो पुराने छात्र एलएल.बी. (2016) तक प्रथम वर्ष के पेपर्स को एक्स स्टूडेंट की तरह पास किए हैं उन्हें एलएल.बी. द्वितीय वर्ष सत्र 2018-19 में प्रथम वर्ष के 9 पेपर्स पास करके द्वितीय वर्ष में promotion लिया है, उन्हें तृतीय और चतुर्थ सेमेस्टर के 10 पेपर्स उत्तीर्ण करने होंगे। यदि उनके ड्यू पेपर्स हैं तो वह ड्यू पेपर्स की परीक्षा जिस सेमेस्टर में भी हो रही है उसी सेमेस्टर में देंगे। संलग्न चार्ट देखें। For promotion to IInd year it is necessary to pass 7 courses with 48% marks in minimum of 4 papers and for IIIrd year admission it is necessary to pass 16 papers with 48 % in minimum of 13 papers.

12. वार्षिक प्रणाली (2016) तक के विद्यार्थी जो तृतीय वर्ष के बाद एक्स स्टूडेंट की तरह अपने ड्यू पेपर सेमेस्टर प्रणाली या Sept 2019 में तो वह पेपर में 36 प्रतिशत अंक प्राप्त करके पास होगा व 48 प्रतिशत का aggregate बनाना पड़ेगा। जो भी विद्यार्थी द्वितीय वर्ष या तृतीय वर्ष में सेमेस्टर सिस्टम में regular पढ़ता है, वह 40 प्रतिशत अंक प्राप्त करके ही उत्तीर्ण होगा और aggregate 48 प्रतिशत अंक हासिल करेगा।
