

## EXAMINATION SCHEME

1. 1 credit = 25 marks for examination/evaluation.
2. For Regular Students there will be continuous assessment, in which sessional work and the terminal examination will contribute to the final grade. Each course in Semester Grade Point Average (SGPA) has two components. Continuous assessment (20% weightage) and End of Semester Examination (EoSE) (80% weightage).
3. For Regular Students 75% Attendance is mandatory for appearing in the EoSE.
4. To appear in the EoSE examination of a course / subject, a regular student must appear in the mid-semester examination and obtain at least C grade in the course / subject.
5. Credit points in a course / subject will be assigned only if the student obtains at least C grade in the CA and EoSE examination of a course / subject.
6. In the case of Non-Collegiate Students there will be no continuous assessment and credit points in a course / subject will be assigned only if the non-collegiate students obtain at least a C grade in the EoSE examination of a course / subject.
